The fine print: You must be a PSC member to sign up for PSC trips. To sign up for a week or longer trip, you must have sailed on at least two weekend trips on PSC chartered boats. Day sails do not qualify as weekend trips, even if two are taken. Unless otherwise noted, payment in full is due at signup, and expenses for preboarding, food, pumpout, fuel, docking, or moorings, if any, are not included in the published prices. These expenses are shared by all crew including ECMs, and typically reconciled at the end of the trip. Cancellation fees are \$40 for weekends and \$75 for weeklong trips, if replaced.
